*Factual Details of your complaint against Judge:

Karen Sage violated multiple Canon's in violation of the Texas Code of Judicial Conduct; the BRIBERY Statue under the United States Code Service (the Grant in question was a US Department of Energy Distributed Renewable Energy Grant under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act 2009 and there are jurisdictional issues also at hand); and other violations of Statute, accepting financial interest (\$250 direct payment on 10/23/2013 from Daniel Wannamaker, who was my first PAID attorney and who was removed from this case for CONFLICT OF INTEREST, and who was subject to disbarment and civil action for reckless and negligent conduct for allowing the DESTRUCTION OF EXONERATING EVIDENCE, in addition to criminal prosecution for Obstruction of Justice in my subsequent Federal case that was a direct result of the State instant case.). See documentary evidence attached.

In addition, Sage was swayed by the Criminal Interference and Obstruction of Justice by State Senator Kirk Watson, who, for a DIRECT PAYMENT of \$25 on 07/25/2013 by Jonestown Mayor Dean Armstrong, went to Sage to keep Armstrong (who should have been indicted) and others, who should have been indicted as well, from prosecution, which, in addition to this case, included the Criminal Obstruction of a Federal bankruptcy proceeding, WDTX 09-13228, directly associated with the Jonestown Wind Project. See documentary evidence attached.

Further substantiation of the BRIBERY allegation came with statements from two Officers of the Court, subject to disbarment for making false and disparaging statements against a Judge, Jackie Wood, my appointed Counsel of Record after Wannamaker was removed on November 5, 2012, and my Appellate Attorney, Arial Payan, who both, individually and separate from each other, a week apart, said that Sage ruled against me for "votes and contributions for her upcoming re-election". See documentary evidence attached.

Deane Armstrong, Mayor of Jonestown, and Jonestown City Council Aldermen Robert Moore, Lance Wedell (who testified for the prosecution at trial), Bill Nichols, Tom Buckle and Joe Aaron actively engaged in DESTROYING MY property and EXONERATING EVIDENCE, in the City of Taylor, and EXONERATING EVIDENCE, in Jonestown, without any legal proceedings or Court Authority, then actively engaged in influencing votes for Karen Sage (and Watson) in Jonestown, Lago Vista and the Travis County precincts of the City of Cedar Park. See Texas Election Commission and Travis County Voters Registration/Information attached as documentary evidence.

Additional proof of the violations of Canon and Statute are evidenced in Sage's DENIALS of key Motions for Directed Verdict, a Franks Hearing, and more, and includes my Motion for New Trial on November 12, 2013 and the DISMISSAL of my Art. 11.07 Writ of Habeas Corpus by Sage on November 20, 2014, AFTER my filing a Federal 2255 Motion on July 9, 2013, a Federal 2254 Motion on September 19, 2014, a formal Complaint to the State Commission on Judicial Conduct on May 14, 2014, CJC No. 14-0826 and after receiving the DIRECT PAYMENT from Wannamaker and the INDIRECT PAYMENT by Armstrong to IMPROPERLY INFLUENCE by Watson.

Allegations of BRIBERY and JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT are all over these Court documents and Sage was well aware of the filings. Sage, to avoid THE APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY, should have declared a Mistrial and at the very least, during several key situations in this case, recused herself from all proceedings. See Exhibits.

In addition to the OVERWHELMING APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY, Sage's DENIAL OF DUE PROCESS as a result of DIRECT and INDIRECT FINANCIAL INTEREST violated Canon and Statute.

Sage benefited from Armstrong and others (involved in the Jonestown Wind Project who were subject to criminal prosecution in several jurisdictions) improper political influence in SEVERAL key voting precincts, to direct votes to Sage and Watson violates Canon and Statute.

The Exhibits with this Complaint contain substantial documentary, video and photographic EVIDENCE and WITNESS information not previously presented.
